Chairman Anderson called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone.

Chairman Anderson stated that on July 20, 2009, the Board of Education presented its Facilities Request for a New Davie High/Auxiliary Campus, Early College Facility Needs to the Board of Commissioners. The commissioners have had two opportunities to ask questions related to the proposed Facilities Request. Following the presentation, members of the Davie County Board of Commissioners and staff, and members of the Davie County Board of Education and staff, answered questions regarding the proposed plan for the New Davie High/Auxiliary Campus, Early College Facility Needs.

Commissioner Jones made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Poindexter seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.
