The Davie County Board of Commissioners met in a special session on Monday, January 11, 2010 at Cornerstone Christian Church, 1585 Highway 801 North, Mocksville, NC.

Chairman Poindexter called the meeting to order at 6:05 p.m. and explained that the purpose of the meeting is to provide factual information concerning the proposed quarter cent local sales tax. Chairman Poindexter turned the meeting over to Ms. Beth M. Dirks, Davie County Manager.


Ms. Dirks stated that the 2007 State Appropriations Act provides counties with the authority to levy a local quarter cent sales tax following approval in a non-binding advisory referendum. A vote on the sales tax is scheduled for February 2, 2010. Polls open at 6:30 a.m. and close at 7:30 p.m.

Ms. Dirks provided information on how the proceeds from the sales tax will be used, (as stated in resolutions adopted by the Davie County Board of Commissioners on November 2, 2009), which counties have already approved the quarter cent sales tax, and what type of items are exempt from the quarter cent sales tax.

Ms. Dirks opened the floor for questions and comments on the proposed quarter cent sales tax.

Commissioner Jones made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:48 p.m. Commissioner Anderson seconded the motion. The motion passed 3 to 0.
